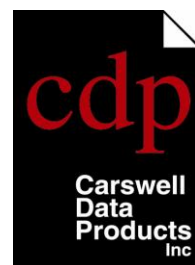


Carswell Data Products, Inc. and Monroe County Community Credit Union Win 2008 *Credit Union Journal* Best Practices Award
